Author of three books; Hunter Seat Equitation, George H. Morris Teaches Beginners to Ride, and Because Every Round Counts, a Medals Final Champion himself, (one of the youngest on record to win both the AHSA Medal Finals and the ASPCA Maclay Finals in the same year) a 1960 Olympian Silver Medalist, Champion in countless International Grand Prixs, coaching multiple students to National and International Grand Prix Wins, and retired USET Chef d'Equipe (Coach). George H. Morris is the most sought after clinician in the world because of his more than 60 years of experience in the sport of show jumping. 
